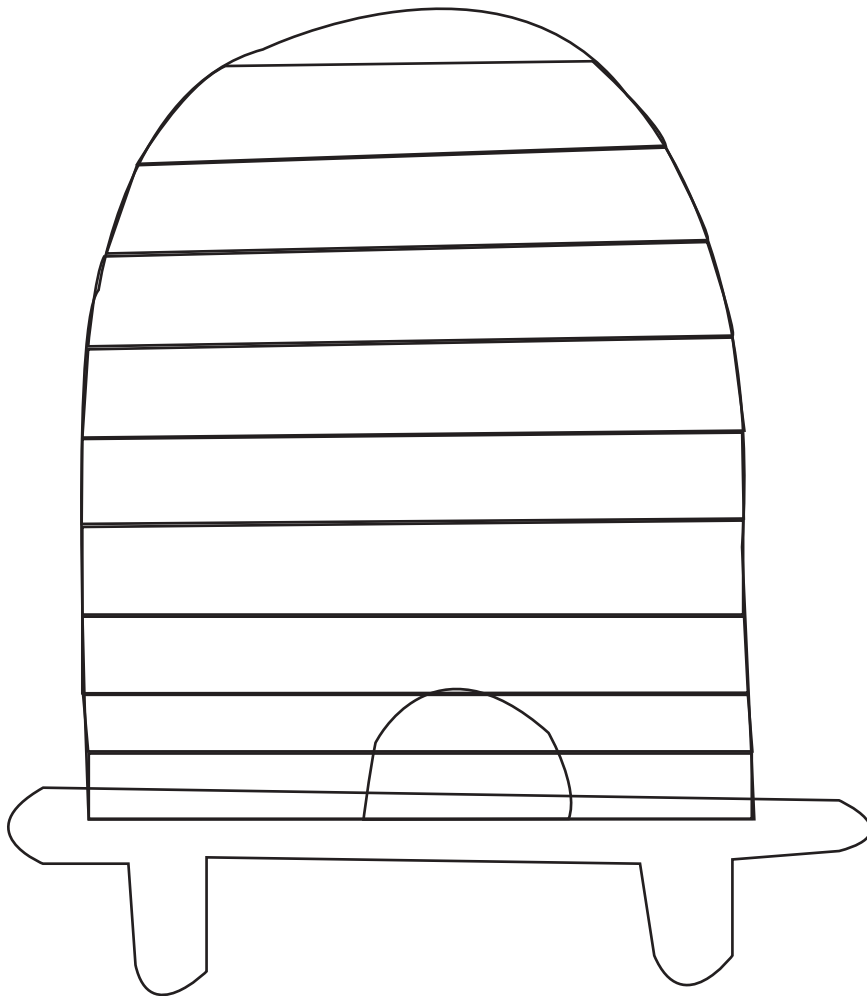
Jan Patek - Block #4- Beeskep

Instructions: (all measurements include seam allowance)

Back

Cut a 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" background block.

Using Freezer Paper Applique directions cut out beeskep, stand and hole. Applique hole to skep and skep to stand. Applique beeskep and stand to background. Embroider lines on beeskep referring to embroidery instructions.



Freezer Paper Applique:

Draw on the matte side and iron shiny side to fabric (iron to the wrong side if you need the pattern reversed). Draw your templates the exact size, do not add seam allowances. Cut out freezer paper templates. Iron onto right side of fabric and cut out adding $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Mark around templates with colored pencil or chalk. This line will help you know where to needle turn. I like to use a sandpaper board to help hold the fabric in place while I'm tracing around the shape. Peel off freezer paper. Freezer paper appliqué templates are reusable.

Place the shapes on the background. Pin, glue stick or baste the shapes into place on the background.

Embroidery Instructions: Trace the bee skep lines on tulle with a permanent marker. Place the tulle over the quilt block and using a quilt marker, retrace the lines. Embroider lines on the block using two strands of cotton floss.
